How to get there:**CPH Airport – Lund C (Central)**

There are direct trains to Lund Central station (Lund C) every 10-15 minutes, almost the entire day and night. The train goes from Denmark to Sweden through the Öresund Bridge (nice views during the day). The train is located at the airport. After collecting your bag, you will go straight until you see red ticket vending machines:



When you buy a ticket, go to the right and down to Track 1. You can use any train that goes through Lund C.

Another option is to download the Skånetrafiken application ([or use their website](#)), and you can buy and use tickets on your phone. A one-way single ticket through Öresund costs 165 SEK (14,4 EUR), and the travel time is 35 min.
